(a): Integrated Skill Development Scheme (ISDS) was implemented till 2018. Presently, Ministry of Textiles is implementing Samarth Scheme for Capacity Building including skill development in Textile Sector.

(b): Details of training centres under Samarth, State wise, including Maharashtra, Karnataka and Uttar Pradesh is given in **Annexure-I**.

(c): Under Samarth scheme, the cost of training programme is released directly to Implementing Partners (IP). Details of budget allocation and utilization during the financial year 2019-20 and the current year is as below:

However, there are 43 (forty three) training centres in the State of Maharashtra set up by various textiles manufacturers for training under the Scheme.
