(a) Yes Sir, a new draft Science, Technology & Innovation Policy (STIP) has been formulated and is presently at consultation stage.

(b) The draft policy is aimed at being bottom up, decentralized, inclusive, evidencedriven and knowledge-supported. The draft STIP envisions the aspirations of a new, future-ready India by ensuring active participation, shared responsibility and equitable ownership of all stakeholders; transforming the national STI landscape maintaining the delicate balance between fortifying India's indigenous capacity and nurturing meaningful global inter-connectedness.

(c) & (d) The draft STI policy document was released for public consultation in English for seeking comments for a period of one month from  $31^{st}$  December 2020 to  $31^{st}$  January 2021.
