Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether with a view to attract more doctors to public sector and reducing cost of medical education, the Government proposes to extend grants in aid to medical colleges set up by State/UTs;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise along with the details of the action plan in place in this regard;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to set up 'Jan Swasthya Vidyalaya' in the country particularly in remote and tribal areas; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise including Chhatisgarh?

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND

(SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)**

(a) & (b): The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare administers a Centrally Sponsored Scheme - 'Establishment of new Medical Colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals' to provide Central funding support for opening of new medical colleges. Under the Scheme, Central funding is provided for opening of medical colleges in districts which do not have either a government or a private medical college. Under three phases of the Scheme, a total of 157 medical colleges have been approved, out of which 47 have become functional. The Ministry also runs Centrally Sponsored Schemes for strengthening/ upgradation of existing State Government / Central Government Medical Colleges to increase MBBS and PG seats. These Scheme seek to provide improved tertiary healthcare and affordable medical education in the country. The State-wise details of funds allocated under these Scheme are at Annexure-I.

Further, under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), this Ministry has taken up upgradation of existing Government Medical Colleges / Institutions in the country. Such upgradation involves setting up of Super Speciality Hospital / Trauma Centre for augmenting the tertiary health care services and improving the quality of medical education. These projects are being implemented by this Ministry Centrally and as such no grant-in-aid is being released to the medical colleges under the Scheme. Under the Scheme, the upgradation projects in the 69 existing Government Medical Colleges have been approved. State/UT wise details are at Annexure-II.
