#### SUPER SPECIALITY HOSPITALS

#### 2006.SHRI SUKHBIR SINGH JAUNAPURIA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) the number of operational and under construction super speciality hospitals in the country, State/UT-wise;

(b) whether the Government proposes to set up such hospitals in each district in the country and if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether any norms have been determined to identify places for each project and the progress made thereon, if so, the details thereof;

(d) the funds allocated and utilised for this purpose during the last three years and the current year, State- wise; and

(e) whether any timeline has been fixed by the Government for the expeditious completion of the above said projects in the country?

#### ANSWER

## THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a) & (b): Health is a State subject and therefore primary responsibility to ensure effective and sufficient health facilities including setting up of super speciality hospitals lies with State Governments. Super speciality hospitals are being constructed both in public and private sector, and data on number of functional / under construction super speciality hospitals is not maintained centrally. However, under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), Government has sanctioned 75 Projects of Up-gradation of existing Government Medical Colleges/Institutions (GMCIs) which includes setting up of 63 Super Specialty Blocks (SSB) in various parts of the country. List of 63 such projects is at Annexure. These projects under PMSSY are implemented on cost sharing basis between Central and State Governments. There is no proposal under PMSSY for setting up of additional super speciality hospitals in each district in the country.

(c): PMSSY aims at correcting the regional imbalances in the availability of the tertiary healthcare and medical education in different parts of the country. The Ministry has, while finalizing the up-gradation projects, given higher priority to the States generally considered backward with respect to the broad socio-economic indicators. Further, State Governments also have to agree to contribute their share in the total cost of the project as well as operate and maintain the facilities created. Therefore, willingness of the State Governments is also important.

(d): The State/UT and project-wise details of approved costs and Central share released is given in Annexure.

(e): Approval of GMCI up-gradation projects also contains timelines for their completion. Progress in implementation is regularly reviewed for expeditious and time-bound completion of projects.
