- (a) whether it is a fact that the Scheme for Integrated Textile Parks (SITP) at Kalaburgi, Karnataka has failed to achieve its objectives;
- (b) if so, whether the Government has constituted any committee to find out the reasons behind failure of fulfillment of SITP in Kalaburagi and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the said committee has submitted its recommendations for setting up of SITP after incorporation of a few changes in the scheme; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the actions taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) to (d): Gulbarga Textile Park, Gulbarga was approved on November 8, 2011 with a project cost of Rs. 46.39 cr of which GoI grant is Rs. 18.56 cr. An amount of Rs. 1.85 cr has been released to the project so far. During Project Approval Committee (PAC) meeting held on 03.12.2019, the SPV stated that the park is facing equity generation issue from last 2-3 years as very small manufacturers are involved in the Park. SPV is also facing some constraints at the level of State Govt. from last 2 years. PAC upon deliberations, observed that the prospect of the park is very low as it is not able to generate enough equity from last 2-3 years. Accordingly, PAC decided to cancel the park.
