- (a) to (c): As per the recommendations of the 15th Finance Commission, Government of India has released the Revenue Deficit Grant of Rs.5,405.59 crore to the State Government of **Andhra Pradesh** in the current financial year 2020-21(up to February 2021).
- (d) The Union Government provides funds/ assistance to the State Governments under Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS), Central Finance Commission grants and Special Assistance as per the guidelines of the respective Schemes within the availability of Gross Budgetary Support with the Central Government. Besides, funds are also released directly to implementing agencies under the Central Sector Schemes (CS) for developmental activities in the States.
