REVIVAL OF CLOSED FACTORIES

2109. DR. A. CHALLAKUMAR:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether the Government is aware that due to closure of factories in large numbers in each year the number of those who have been rendered jobless is increasing continuously;
- (b)if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c)whether the Government proposes to provide economic aid to revive the closed factories;
- (d)if so, the details thereof; and
- (e)the other measures taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

- (a) & (b): On the basis of voluntary returns received by Labour Bureau from the Labour Departments of the State/Union Territories, the number of closures and workers affected during the last 3 years is given at Annexure I.
- (c) to (e): The following schemes are presently being implemented as measures to provide economic aid to revive closed factories:

- i)Aatmanirbhar Bharat Rozgar Yojna (ABRY) incentivize creation of new employment along with social security benefits and restoration of loss of employment during COVID-19 Pandemic. The scheme reduces the financial burden of the employers of various sectors/industries including MSME and encourages them to hire more workers.
- ii) Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana (PMGKY)- Under the scheme Government of India has contributed both 12% employer's share and 12% employee's share under Employees Provident Fund(EPF), totaling 24% of the wage for the wage month from March to August 2020 for the establishment having upto 100 employees with 90% of such employees earning less than Rs.15000/-.

iii)RBI and Government of India have taken measures to infuse liquidity in the economy to sustain the market economy and raise the level of employment.
