**Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has any scheme to solve the problem of increasing unemployment;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) the total number of employment avenues generated in the country during the last one year and the State-wise details thereof; and**
- (d) the number of persons registered under Pradhan Mantri Shrama Yogi Maandhan scheme during the last six months?**

**ANSWER**

**(a) to (c): Employment generation coupled with improving employability is the priority of the Government. Government has taken various steps for generating employment in the country like encouraging various projects involving substantial investment and increasing public expenditure on schemes like Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), Pt. Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) and Deendayal Antodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) run by Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises, Ministry of Rural Development and Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs, respectively. The State/UT-wise details of the schemes/ programmes are at Annexure.**

**Government is implementing Pradhan Mantri Rojgar Protsahan Yojana (PMRPY) in the country since 2016 with the objective to incentivise employers for creation of new employment with social security benefits. Under the scheme, Government of India is paying Employer's full contribution i.e. 12% towards EPF and EPS both (as admissible from time to time) for a period of three years to the new employees through EPFO. The terminal date for registration of beneficiary through establishment was 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019. The beneficiaries registered upto 31st March, 2019 will continue to receive the benefits for 3 years from the date of registration under the scheme.**

**Aatmanirbhar Bharat Rozgar Yojana (ABRY) Scheme has been launched by the Government to incentivize creation of new employment along with social security benefits and restoration of loss of employment during COVID-19 pandemic. This scheme being implemented through the Employees Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO), reduces the financial burden of the employers of various sectors/industries including MSMEs and encourages them to hire more workers. Under ABRY, Government of India is crediting for a period of two years, both the employees' share (12% of wages) and employers' share (12%**

**of wages) of contribution payable or only the employees' share, depending on employment strength of the EPFO registered establishments.**

**Government of India under PM- SVANidhi Scheme has facilitated collateral free working capital loan upto Rs.10,000/- for one-year tenure to street vendors, to resume their businesses.**

**In addition, RBI and Government of India have introduced measures to infuse liquidity in the economy to sustain the market economy and raise the level of employment.**

**Under Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY) for facilitating self-employment, collateral free loans upto Rs. 10 lakh, are extended to micro/small business enterprises and to individuals to enable them to setup or expand their business activities.**

**(d): 51187 persons have been enrolled/ registered under Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maan-dhan Scheme during the last six months i.e. from September, 2020 to February, 2021.**
