- (b) There is no proposal to change the criteria fixed for the Gandhi Peace Prize.
- (c) Following is the procedure as per Code of Procedure for Gandhi Peace Prize:
- i) The Ministry requests nominations for the Gandhi Peace Prize every year.
- ii) The Jury shall consider such nominations and the final selection for the Award shall be made by a Jury appointed by the Government.
- iii) The Jury shall comprise five members, the Prime Minister of India, who would chair the Jury; the Chief Justice of India; the Leader of Opposition recognized as such in the Lok Sabha or where there is no such Leader of Opposition then, the Leader of the single largest opposition party in that House; and two other eminent persons.
- iv) Award is given for social, economic and political transformation through Non-violence and other Gandhian methods.
- v) The Award is open to all persons regardless of nationality, race, creed or sex.
