## MoU BETWEEN NBCFDC AND APOLLO MEDICALS

Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the National Backward Classes Finance and Development Corporation (NBCFDC) and Apollo Medicals have signed a Memorandum of Understanding(MoU) to provide vaccination training to nurses and pharmacists belonging to Other Backward Classes and Economically Weaker Sections utilizing the funding of NBCFDC;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the number of persons targeted to be trained during the next few months under this MoU?

## **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT (SHRI KRISHAN PAL GURJAR)

- (a) & (b): Yes, Sir. The National Backward Classes Finance and Development Corporation (NBCFDC) has signed an MOU with M/s. Apollo Medskills Pvt Ltd. for providing COVID Vaccination Administration training programme (as per guidelines of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare) to Nurses, Medical & Nursing students and Pharmacist belonging to the target group of National Backward Classes Finance and Development (NBCFDC) on a co-funding basis. The programme has been sanctioned with the aim of Up-Skilling the competency level of the health care-workers as well contributing to the national programme of Vaccination under progress.
- (c) The Corporation has sanctioned training programme for 1000 trainees in the state of Bihar, Delhi, Telangana, Tamil Nadu and Uttar Pradesh, which are expected to be commenced in due course.
