- (a) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to promote horticulture and floriculture; and
- (b) the funds utilized to promote horticulture and floriculture during the current year and the last three years and State-wise details thereof?

- (a): Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH), a centrally sponsored scheme is being implemented for the holistic development of horticulture (including floriculture) in the country. All States/UTs are covered under MIDH. Under MIDH, for promotion of horticulture (including floriculture) throughout the country, financial & technical assistance is provided to States/UTs for following major interventions/activities:
- Setting up of nurseries, tissue culture units for production of quality seed and planting material.
- Area expansion i.e. Establishment of new orchards and gardens for fruits, vegetables, and flowers.
- Rejuvenation of unproductive, old, and senile orchards.
- Protected cultivation, i.e. poly-house, green-house, etc, to improve the productivity & grow off season high value vegetables and flowers.
- Organic farming and certification.
- Creation of water resources structures and watershed management.
- Bee-keeping for pollination.
- Horticulture Mechanization.
- Creation of Post Harvest Management and Marketing infrastructure.
