REHABILITATION/ASSISTANCE TO FISHERMEN COMMUNITIES

2430. DR VISHNU PRASAD M.K.:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING मत्स्यपालन, पश्पालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal for rehabilitation/assistance of fishermen communities affected by cyclones/sea erosion in various States;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the State Government of Tamil Nadu has submitted any proposal for release of funds from the Union Government for rehabilitation of fishermen; and
- (d) the details of the steps being taken by the Union Government for construction of sea wall to protect fishermen from cyclones?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRYAND DAIRYING

- (a) and (b): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries Animal Husbandry and Dairying supplements the efforts of the State/UT Government for overall development of fisheries and aquaculture including providing assistance for safety of fishermen at sea. With regards to providing rehabilitation/assistance of fishermen communities affected by cyclones/sea erosion, the primary responsibility rest with the State/UT Government. The Ministry of Home Affairs renders assistance to State Government during natural calamities/disasters.
- (c) Presently no proposal relating to rehabilitation of fishermen is pending with Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India.
- (d) Under the Scheme and Programme implemented by the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries Animal Husbandry and Dairying, there is no provision for construction of sea wall.
