- (b) whether a large number of roads are yet to be completed under the PMGSY in the State;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the target set for the years 2020-21 and 2021-22 to provide rural connectivity under PMGSY?

(a) The details of progress made in the construction of roads in the State of Odisha under various verticals of Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) as on 31st March, 2020 are as under:-

(d) During 2020-21, against the target of construction of 3,685 km road length, a total of 1,457 km road length has been constructed in the State of Odisha. As against the target of connecting 317 habitations, 253 have been connected by the State as on 3rd March, 2021. The targets for 2021-22 has not yet been fixed.
