Will the Minister of Electronics & Information Technology be pleased to state:

- (a) the salient features of Digital Gram Yojna;
- (b) the details of funds approved, allocated and utilized in Rajasthan so far under the scheme, District-wise;
- (c) the number of villages and districts covered under the scheme in Rajasthan so far;
- (d) the details of the villages selected so far under the scheme in Dausa district of Rajasthan;
- (e) the details of target fixed and achievements made by the Government under the scheme; and
- (f) whether the Government is planning to link some more villages under the scheme and if so, the time by when these villages are likely to be linked?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI SANJAY DHOTRE)

- (a): Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) had initiated the Digital Village Pilot Project titled "Pilot Project-Implementation of Digital Village" on 31st October 2018 for duration of 3 years and not Digital Gram Yojna. 700 Gram Panchayats (GP)/Village (atleast one Gram Panchayat/village from each district of the State/UT) are being covered under the pilot implementation of the project. The Deliverables of the project are in the areas of Health, Education, Skill Development, and Financial Inclusion including G2C & B2C:
 - i. Education Service: Courses offered under this project are as (i) Basic Computer Course (BCC), (ii) Course on Computer Concept (CCC), (iii) Tally Kaushal Praman Patra
 - ii. Health Services Tele-Health & Tele-Veterinary consultation
 - iii. Financial Inclusion- Financial inclusion Awareness programme
 - iv. Solar street lights (8 Solar lights per village)
 - v. Skill Development skill development in (i) Automotive Technician, (ii) Handset repairing, (iii) Field Technician- Home Appliances, and (iv) Electrical Technician.
- (b): The Digital Village Pilot Project is being implemented across India through CSC e-Governance Service India Limited under the Digital India Scheme which is a Central Sector Scheme of Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology. The tentative funds requirement for the State of Rajasthan, under the project, to cover 33 villages is approximately Rs.329.83lakhs. The funds utilization is as below:
