IRCTC has a duly approved CSR & Sustainability Policy formulated in accordance to the following:

The company follows an elaborate process to identify, streamline and plan activities under its CSR initiative. Discussions and deliberations regarding its CSR activities are primarily organized between the following Two Tiers:

Tier-I: Board Level Committee or Tier-I Committee (T1C) headed by the Chairman and the Managing Director/ Independent Director

- **Composition and allocation of roles and responsibilities for the Below Board Level CSR Committee**
- **Review, approve and amend the CSR Policy (Vision) Document**
- **Review and approve CSR management process and provide inputs and directions to the CSR Committee, as and when needed.**
- **Recommend and approve the annual CSR expenditure, considering the provisions of Section 135 of Companies Act, 2013 read with Companies (Corporate Social Responsibility) Rules 2014 which states that at least 2% of average net profits of the Company made during the three immediately pending financial years are to be earmarked as CSR budget.**
- **Overall management along with impact assessment and future plan of action**

Tier-II: Below Board Level Committee or Tier-II Committee (T2C) headed by the CSR Nodal Officer of the rank of Group General Manager to function as the “Nodal Officer”. The designated Nodal Officer has a team of dedicated three officials to assist him in co-ordination work, which in

no way detract from the CSR and Sustainability work. This committee is the Central CSR Office of IRCTC and it carries out the day to day operations. Apart from the aforementioned dedicated personnel for CSR under the Nodal Officer, the T2C also includes experts for Finance, IT and Legal on an ‘as and when needed’ basis. For the implementation of projects, the T2C identifies IRCTC personnel at the Zonal and Regional level. This team is called the “Implementation Surveillance Group” (ISG) which is also incharge of monitoring of the local level projects. The progress of project at the local level is monitored by the “Implementation Surveillance Group” and reported to the T2C. The T2C has the following roles and responsibilities:

- Plan, implement and execute CSR projects across sectors in accordance to the approved theme of activities such as, education, health/ nutrition.
- Review implementation process of all CSR activities including identification and timely assessment of the projects.
- Ensure meetings of the CSR Committee are held regularly.
- Prepare and maintain relevant documents, reports and files for the company records and to present in front of the Board of Directors.

Mumbai Railway Vikas Corporation Limited:

CSR Activities undertaken by the Corporation during 2020-21

(a) Health Services:

The Corporation set up a Health Centre at Lallubhai Compound, Mankhurd, Mumbai primarily for the project affected people in the resettlement colony. It provides health care services on daily basis including General OPD, Dental OPD, Tuberculosis treatment, Immunization and family planning with maternal and child health services. In the health centre, specialized services like Physiotherapy and Disability rehabilitation, Gynecology clinic, Eye clinic, Chronic disease and Skin disorders are also provided. The OPD services are backed up by laboratory services and pharmacy. With the opening of the health centre, affordable quality health services are easily accessible to residents of the resettlement colonies and nearby slum areas.

The Health Centre has been providing health care services to more than 1.5 Lakhs people. In 2020-2021, there are 37967 beneficiaries in General OPD, 20948 beneficiaries in MCH and 6785 beneficiaries in Special OPDs, which include Gynaec, Opthal, Ortho, skin and Chronic OPD. Also in this year, outreach Services covered approx 14752 beneficiaries, with 713 ANC Patients Survey, Registration, vaccination and follow up under UNICEF project. Further, during the COVID-19 pandemic, awareness programs have been regularly organized and swab testing facility provided apart from other essential services.

(b) Water Sanitation and Hygiene Activity:

Apart from services at the health centre, awareness activities concerning health services, water sanitation and hygiene activities are also carried out in the resettlement colony through community meetings, rally, street plays etc. The main aim of the project is to provide preventive and curative health care services. Hygiene Activities include Hand Wash Session, Swachhata Pakhawada, Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan, which covered approx..8052 beneficiaries. The Awareness Session covered 120 Locations, with approx. 204000 beneficiaries.
