(a) to (e): In the meeting between the Minister for Commerce and Industry, Government of India and Secretary of State for International Trade, UK held on 6 th February 2021 in New Delhi, discussions were held on the India-UK bilateral trade and investment relationship. Both Ministers reiterated their commitment to a long term India-UK partnership and agreed to deepen trade cooperation between the two countries through an Enhanced Trade Partnership (ETP).

The Ministers also committed to relaunch the India-UK CEO Forum and agreed on its meeting at the earliest. Government is actively engaged to discuss all trade matters with the UK for furtherance of India's economic relations with the UK.
