INTERNET FACILITY IN BIHAR

2617. SHRI JANARDAN SINGH SIGRIWAL:

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has provided internet and Wi-Fi facilities in villages of the country particularly in Bihar for the benefit of farmers with a view to enhance their knowledge in agro-sector and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) the action being taken by the Government to enhance internet facility in the rural and remote areas of the country?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS, EDUCATION AND ELECTRONICS & INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI SANJAY DHOTRE)

(a) & (b) Internet is being provided in rural areas by the Government and the Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) through 3G/4G wireless mobile and fixed wireline broadband. In addition to this, Government of India is implementing BharatNet project to provide broadband connectivity to all the Gram Panchayats (GPs) (approx. 2,50,000) in the country. As a part of BharatNet project, the Last Mile connectivity is being provided through Wi-Fi or any other suitable broadband technology.

The status of Internet facility in rural & remote areas of the country including Bihar, as on 26.02.2021, is as follows:
