Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state : -

- (a) the number of tiger deaths reported by National Tiger Conservation Authority during the last three years State/UT-wise; and
- (b) the schemes being implemented by the Government to increase forest cover in cities during the said period?

#### ANSWER

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

- (a) The details of tiger deaths as reported by States, during the last three years are at **Annexure-I.**
- (b) To increase forest cover in cities, Nagar Van-Udyan Yojana is being implemented by the National CAMPA Advisory Council (NCAC) from Compensatory Afforestation Fund, since 2015 as a pilot scheme. An amount of Rs. 5124.05 lakhs has been released to 46 approved projects under Nagar Van-Udyan Yojana during the year 2015-2018. The scheme Nagar Van-Udyan has been restructured during the year 2020 and now implemented as Nagar Van Yojana (NVY), for creation of 200 'city forests', primarily on forest lands, in cities having a Municipal Corporation or Municipalities over a period of five years (2020-21 to 2024-25).
