2837. SHRI VINCENT H. PALA:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of projects approved along with funds released/employment generation reported using CAMPA funds under AtmaNirbhar Bharat Package in the year, 2020-2021, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the total number of jobs created for vulnerable tribal population under projects utilising CAMPA funds in the last two years, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether there is any time bound process and monitoring mechanism for completion of projects under Atma Nirbhar Bharat Package; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

- (a) & (b) On 12.05.2020 Hon'ble Prime Minister of India announced a special economic package of 20,00,000 crore under Atma Nirbhar Bharat. This package also included 6,000 crore employment push using CAMPA funds to create job opportunities including for tribal communities in semi-urban and rural areas. Against this, the National Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (National Authority) has approved Annual Plans of Operation (APOs) of 31 States/UTs amounting to 7904.16 crore as on 28.02.2021. As per information received from States/UTs 4,83,59,947 man-days have been generated till 05.03.2021 from 31 States/UTs. The information is attached at **Annexure-I.**
- (c) & (d) Yes Sir, Monitoring of projects are done as per established monitoring mechanism of the respective State Governments/UT Administration, which includes monitoring by the officers and staff of the State Government/UT Administration as well as specialized wings of the State Forest Department. External evaluation is also undertaken by the States/UTs. At National level a Monitoring Group has been constituted as per provision in the Compensatory Afforestation Fund (CAF),Act 2016.
