- (b) if so, the details thereof;

- (d) the details of training programmes being implemented by the Government?

(a) to(d) Anganwadi Workers are provided job training for 26 working days during which the knowledge, understanding and skills of Anganwadi workers on various Acts, policies, programmes related to women and children, setting up of vibrant Anganwadi Centres, conducting Early Childhood Care and Education activities, health and nutrition care of children and women, Community Mobilisation, Awareness, Advocacy & IEC, Management of AWC and hands on experience through supervised practice to work in Anganwadi Centres are developed.

Anganwadi Workers are encouraged for optimal utilization of online training viz. e-Learning which is an interactive, user friendly and self-study platform created to provide access to technical concepts and Electronic Incremental Learning Approach (e-ILA), covering thematic modules on maternal, infant and young child nutrition.
