Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the budgetary allocation for the Ministry has been below one percent of the total budget despite Government assurances and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor:
- (b) whether the Nirbhaya Fund has largely been underutilized and underfunded and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the total funds utilised for establishment of crisis centres for the victims of rape and domestic violences, shelter homes for women, female police volunteers and a dedicated helpline?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) A budgetary provision of Rs. 24435 Crore for the year 2021-22 has been made for the Ministry of Women & Child Development. Allocations are made on the basis of expenditure trends as well as available resources with the Government.
- (b) & (c) No Sir, since, the inception of the scheme/ projects worth Rs. 9288.45 Crore have been appraised and an amount of Rs.3544.06 crore has been disbursed/ released by the concerned Ministries.

This Ministry implements three schemes under Nirbhaya Fund namely One Stop Centre (OSC), Women Helpline (WHL) and Mahila Police Volunteers (MPVs) and 2 schemes namely Swadhar & Ujjawala schemes for women Shelter Homes. The details of total funds released under these schemes are placed at **Annexure-I.**
