#### **Environmental Clearance to Coal Mining Projects**

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government has received proposals from the State Government of Jharkhand for environmental clearance to coal mining projects in Bokaro, Giridih, Dhanbad and Ramgarh districts of Jharkhand;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the environmental clearances have been granted to the proposed projects;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons for delay in granting environmental clearances; and
- (e) the action taken by the Government to give environmental clearance to such projects?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

(a) to (e) Ministry has received total 10 Coal Mining proposals from the State of Jharkhand seeking Environmental Clearance (EC) during the last one year (i.e. March, 2020 till date). Out of which, Environment Clearance to 7 proposals have been granted and 3 are at different stages of appraisal. The status of project received for Environment Clearance from March, 2020 to till date is provided at Annexure I, while status of proposal on which EC was granted is at Annexure-II

Environment Clearances are granted by the Ministry after the appraisal and recommendation of a technical committee (Expert Appraisal Committee) as per the Schedule I mandated in Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Notification, 2006. In order to facilitate expeditious appraisal and grant of Environment Clearance, Ministry has implemented the online Portal called as PARIVESH for submitting the application by Project Proponents and regularly conducting the Expert Appraisal Committee meeting for early appraisal of projects.
