DAILY VACCINATION RATE FOR COVID-19

2981. SHRI MOHAMMED FAIZAL P.P.: SHRI MANISH TEWARI:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the current daily vaccination rate for COVID-19 is sufficient to meet the proposed target of vaccinating 300 million people by August, 2020, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) if not, whether the Government is planning to increase the daily vaccination rate in order to meet its target;
- (c) the number of people inoculated with the second dose of vaccine so far; and
- (d) whether the Government has noted that only one in ten people have got inoculated with the second dose, if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a) & (b): The current rate of COVID-19 vaccination is satisfactory and is being further increased through increase in number of COVID-19 Vaccination Centres (CVCs) in both government and private health facilities.

In view of dynamic nature of COVID-19 pandemic and inclusion of new priority groups, no specific time frame is fixed for completion of vaccination.

(c) & (d): As on 8th March 2021, a total of 37.61 lakh beneficiaries have received 2nd dose of COVID-19 vaccine. These include 66.67% & 43.50% of the eligible beneficiaries for 2nd dose amongst Health Care Workers and Front Line Workers respectively.
