INCREASING SEATS IN KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS

3084. SHRI M. SELVARAJ:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to open a Kendriya Vidyalaya school in each districts of Tamil Nadu;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has any proposal to increase the seat strength of each classes of bifurcated Kendriya Vidyalaya schools in Tamil Nadu;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (e) whether the Government is aware that there is a huge demand from the people of Nagapattinum and Mayiladuthurai districts to open a Kendriya Vidyalaya school in both these districts; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')

- (a) & (b) Opening of new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) is a continuous process. Proposals for opening of new KVs are considered only if sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India / State Governments / Union Territories (UTs) Administrations, committing resources, including land, temporary accommodation etc. as per prescribed norms of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) for setting up a new KV. The proposals received from various sponsoring authorities for opening of new KVs complete in all respects have to compete with other proposals under the "Challenge Method".
- (c) & (d) There is no such proposal under consideration.
- (e) & (f) Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has informed that no proposals in the prescribed proforma have been received for opening of new KVs at Nagapattinam and Mayiladuthurai districts of Tamilnadu.
