MARATHI SPEAKING PEOPLE AT KARNATAKA-MAHARASHTRA BORDER

†3287. SHRIMATI BHAVANA PUNDALIKRAO GAWALI:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the native language of the major portion of population residing at the Karnataka-Maharashtra Border areas is Marathi;
- (b) the names of the main cities/villages having such a population;
- (c) whether there is a long-standing demand to make the Marathi dominated region at the Maharashtra- Karnataka Border a Union territory;
- (d) if so, whether any representation has been received by the Union Government in this regard;
- (e) if so, the details thereof;
- (f) whether the Government proposes to declare the said Marathi dominated region as Union Territory;
- (g) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (h) the immediate steps being taken by the Union Government to safeguard the interests of the Marathi speaking population?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

(a) to (b): As per Census 2011, Marathi speaking population in border sub-districts of Maharashtra-Karnataka is 55,98,325. In the towns / cities of Dudhani, Ichalkaranji, Kagal, Kamalnagar, Maindargi, Nipani, Sadalgi and Sankeshwar, Marathi speaking population were found during Census 2011.

(c) to (h): Demands and representations have been received from time to time from various individuals and organisations to make the Marathi dominated area in Karnataka bordering Maharashtra as a Union Territory. However, no such proposal is under consideration.
