- (a) the details of the scheme likely to be formulated by the Government with regard to manufacturing and operation of electric two wheeler and four wheeler vehicles;
- (b) whether the Government has fixed any time-limit for the operation of electric run vehicles;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether any route has been determined for the operation of electric run vehicles; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (e): Sir, Department of Heavy Industry (DHI) formulated a scheme namely Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of (Hybrid &) Electric Vehicles in India (FAME India) Scheme in 2015 to promote adoption of electric/hybrid vehicles (xEVs) including electric two wheeler and four wheeler vehicles in India. At present, Phase-II of FAME India Scheme is being implemented w.e.f. 01st April, 2019 for a period of 3 years with a total budgetary support of Rs. 10,000 crores. This phase focusses on supporting electrification of public & shared transportation and aims to support, through subsidies, 7090 e-Buses, 5 lakh e-3 Wheelers, 55000 e-4 Wheeler Passenger Cars and 10 lakh e-2 Wheelers. In addition, creation of charging infrastructure is also supported to address range anxiety among users of electric vehicles. The scheme is implemented on pan India basis.
