Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the import of chemicals and petrochemicals has increased during the last three years;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether there is a decline in domestic production of chemicals and petrochemicals during the said period; and
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor along with the details of the remedial measures taken to meet the growing domestic demand?

(a) & (b) Yes, Sir. The import of chemical and chemical products for last three years is as under:

The import of Chemicals and Petrochemicals increased due to major factors such as insufficient domestic production capacity to meet the growing domestic demand, comparatively higher cost of production in the country, and also due to comparatively smaller scale of operations.

(c) & (d) Based on Domestic production of major chemicals and petrochemicals monitored by the Department, production of major chemicals and petrochemicals in last three years has increased and details are as under:
