(a) the quantum of fertilizers produced by the cooperative and public sector companies of the country during the last four years, company and year-wise;

(b) the quantum of fertilizers required for the farmers annually in the county;

the extent to which the domestic production meets the demand of fertilizers by the farmers during the said period, year-wise;

(d) the details and quantum of fertilizers imported during the said period, year-wise;

and

(e) the steps taken by the Government to minimise the dependence on import?

ANSWER

(a): The quantum of fertilizers produced by the Cooperative and Public Sector companies in the country during the last four years company-wise and year-wise are at **Annexure.**

(e): The Government had announced New Investment Policy (NIP) -2012 on 2^{nd} January, 2013 and its amendment on 7^{th} October, 2014 to facilitate fresh investment in the urea sector and to make India self-sufficient in the urea sector. Under NIP -2012 read with its amendment, Matix and CFCL have set up Greenfield and Brownfield urea plants respectively. Further, a decision has been taken to revive 4 closed units of the FCIL namely Gorakhpur, Sindri, Talcher and Ramagundam and one closed unit of HCFL namely Barauni by setting up of new Ammonia-Urea complex. Each of these units has the installed capacity of 12.7 LMT per year.

The Government of India has also notified the New Urea Policy (NUP) -2015 on 25^{th} May, 2015 for existing 25 gas based urea units with the objective of maximizing indigenous urea production; promoting energy efficiency in urea production; and rationalizing subsidy burden on the Government. NUP-2015 has led to additional production from the existing gas based urea plants.

These measures are meant to reduce the dependence on import of urea.
