City Compost Scheme

Will the Minister of **CHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS** be pleased to state :

- (a) the main purpose of the city compost scheme;
- (b) whether villages would be adopted by the fertilizer companies to promote the use of compost; and
- (c) if so, the name of the villages adopted for this purpose in Gujarat?

ANSWER

(SHRI D.V. SADANANDA GOWDA)

(a): The main objective of the City Compost Scheme is to reduce the volume of waste to land fill/dumpsite by converting the waste into useful organic fertilizers and complementing the objectives of "SWACHH BHARAT ABHIYAN" campaign of Government.

(b) & (c): To promote the use of city compost, the Fertilizers marketing Companies have adopted 498 villages across the Country. A list of 56 villages adopted by the fertilizer marketing companies in Gujarat is at **Annexure**.
