(a) to (c): Yes, Sir. During various interactions with developers, investors and other stakeholders, various issues including longer lease period for commercially developed assets, multiple sub leasing and simplified bid procedures were raised. In response to the suggestions received from the developers, investors and other stakeholders, revised scheme for redevelopment of stations has been formulated. Ministry of Railways, through various agencies, is undertaking techno-economic feasibility studies of Railway stations. Based on the outcome of these feasibility studies, stations are being taken up for redevelopment in phases, especially the stations located in major cities, pilgrimage centres and important tourist destinations.
