†3534. SHRI SUNIL KUMAR SINGH: SHRI SUMEDHANAND SARASWATI:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of various categories of trains including passenger trains, express, mail trains, super fast trains, MEMU trains were running before lockdown in the country and the zone-wise and Division-wise, details thereof;
- (b) the zone-wise and division-wise details of the number of special trains that are being run at present post lockdown;
- (c) whether unreserved general boggies are being attached to these trains;
- (d) if so, the time by which the rest of the trains are likely to be operated like before;
- (e) whether the stoppages of these trains at several stations have been discontinued after reintroduction of trains; and
- (f) if so, the reasons therefor along with the division-wise details thereof?

(a) & (b) Trains on Indian Railways are operated on Zonal Railways' ownership basis. The zone-wise details of average daily number of trains operated during pre-COVID period and that being operated presently is tabulated below:

- (c) The Special trains presently being operated do have unreserved coaches in their composition. However, in view of pandemic situation, unreserved second class in long distance Mail/Express trains, has been declared as reserved second class.
- (d) to (f) To prevent the spread of COVID-19 pandemic, Indian Railways discontinued all regular passenger carrying trains w.e.f. 23rd March, 2020 and presently only special trains, with limited stoppages, keeping in view the suggestions and concerns of the State Governments are being operated. The numbers of services are being increased in a phased manner and as on 12th March, 2021, Indian Railways has started operation of a total of 8474 train services which includes 2328 Mail/Express trains and 784 Passenger trains. Besides, Indian Railways is keeping a close watch on the situation by regularly monitoring the waiting list, undertaking temporary augmentation, operating clone train (wherever required) and is resuming train services in a phased manner keeping in view the health protocols and feedback from states.
