MINING OF GEMSTONES

†3545 SHRI ASHOK MAHADEORAO NETE:

Will the Minister of MINES be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the places where the precious/semi-precious gemstones are available, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to implement any special scheme to improve mining and exploitation of deposits of the said stones in the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof as on date;
- (d) the State-wise quantum of gemstones in the said deposits in the country;
- (e) the year-wise quantum of gemstones extracted during the last three years till date along with the value thereof and the extent to which these have been utilised in local markets?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF MINES, COAL AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI PRALHAD JOSHI)

- (a): The details of the places (State wise) where precious/semi-precious gemstones are available is given in Annexure-1.
- (b) & (c): The National Mineral Policy 2019 has the vision for exploration, extraction and management of minerals which have to be guided by national goals and perspectives. To achieve the vision the Government has proposed to bring structural reforms in mining sector through Amendment to the Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957. The Bill has been introduced in Lok Sabha on 15.03.2021. The said amendments, *inter-alia*, has the proposal to make National Mineral Exploration Trust an autonomous body and attract more private player in the field of exploration.
- (d): The quantum of gemstone resource (precious and semi-precious) (all categories) in the country is given in Annexure-2.
- (e): The mineral wise details of gemstones extracted/produced (all categories) during 2017-2018 to 2019-20 and 2020-21 (upto January 2021) is given in Annexure-3. Data on details of gem stones utilised in local market is not maintained by the Ministry.
