**(a) & (c): The Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs is implementing Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) since Financial Year (FY) 2014-15, to reduce poverty and vulnerability of urban poor households by enabling them to access gainful self-employment and skilled wage employment opportunities, for improvement in their livelihoods on a sustainable basis. The mission aims at building strong grass root level institutions of the urban poor, providing shelters equipped with**

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**essential services to the urban homeless persons and addressing livelihood concerns of the urban street vendors by facilitating access to suitable spaces, institutional credit, social security, etc. A statement showing state-wise number of NULM beneficiaries in the last 3 years i.e. 2017-18 to 2019-20 is attached as Annexure-I.**

**(b): A statement showing the state-wise fund released in the last three years is attached as Annexure – II.**

**(d) to (e): National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) under the aegis of Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE), along with IT-ITeS Sector Skill Council (NASSCOM) has designed and developed Qualification Packs – National Occupational Standards across various emerging technologies, including Artificial Intelligence and Big Data Analytics.**
