**(a) to (d) The Government of India has sanctioned Patna Metro Rail Project in February, 2019 with a total completion cost of ₹ 13,365.77 crores and project completion period of 5 years. The project envisages construction of two corridors namely Danapur to Mithapur and Patna Railway Station to New ISBT with a total length of 31.39 km. Patna Metro Rail Corporation Limited (PMRC) has entered into an agreement with Delhi Metro Rail Corporation Limited (DMRC) for execution of the project on deposit terms in September, 2019. Several civil Tenders for corridors I & II have been awarded and work has commenced.**
