Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

(a) the steps being taken by the Government for better implementation of Digital India Programme;

(b) the action plan formulated by the Government for providing Broadband connectivity to each Gram Panchayat of the country; and

(c) the district-wise population of Gram Panchayats in Rajasthan which are still deprived of broadband connectivity at present?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS, EDUCATION AND ELECTRONICS & INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI SANJAY DHOTRE)

(a) Government of India has initiated the 'Digital India Programme" with the vision to transform India into a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy. The Digital India programme is centred on three key vision areas namely Digital Infrastructure as a Core Utility to Every Citizen, Governance and Services on Demand and Digital Empowerment of Citizens. Digital India is an umbrella programme that covers multiple projects of various central Ministries/Departments & States/UTs and accordingly project-plans are charted out by the implementing Ministry/departments.

(b) Government of India is implementing BharatNet project in a phased manner to provide broadband connectivity to all the Gram Panchayats (GPs) (approx. 2,50,000) in the country through optimal mix of media(OFC/Radio/Satellite). As on 15.01.2021, a total of 1,51,404 GPs including Block Headquarters have been made service ready.

(c) The district-wise details of Gram Panchayats in Rajasthan where connectivity is not there is at Annexure.
