Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government plans to implement new schemes to promote the scout and guides movement in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the total budgetary allocations for the National Youth Development and contribution from non budgetary sources;
- (c) whether measures have been taken to promote National Service Scheme and Scout and Guide movement in every school and university in the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS {KIREN RIJIJU}

- (a) This Ministry runs a Scheme namely "Assistance to Scouting & Guiding" under which funds in the form of grant in aid are released to Scouting & Guiding Organisations for conducting Scouting & Guiding activities across the country. No new scheme is envisaged.
- (b) The total Budgetary allocation for National Youth Development is as under:

This Ministry releases financial assistance to NGOs in the form of grant-in-aid to promote scout & guide activities across the country.
