- (d) the action taken by the Government thereon; and
- (e) the bid amount fixed by the Government and total revenue expected through this auction?

- (a) to (b) Bids for tranche five of Toll-Operate Transfer(TOT) i.e., TOT Bundle 5(A-1) and TOT Bundle 5(A-2) in the state of Gujarat [Palanpur-Radhanpur Samakhiyali Section of NH-27 (Km 589.6 to Km 430)] were invited by NHAI on 24.09.2020.
- (c) 6 bids for each bundle were received by NHAI from the following bidders:
 - 1. M/s Adani Road Transport Limited Skylark Infra Engineering Pvt. Ltd.
 - 2. M/s Cube Highways and Infrastructure III Pte Ltd.
 - 3. M/s D.P. Jain & Co. Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd.
 - 4. M/s Indian Highway Concessions Trust
 - 5. M/s IRB Infrastructure Developers Ltd.
 - 6. M/s Prakash Asphaltings and Toll Highways India Ltd

(d) to (e) Initial Estimated Concession Value (IECV) or reserve price determined for TOT Bundle 5(A-1) and TOT Bundle 5(A-2) is Rs.800 crore and Rs.821 crore respectively.
