**NO. 3855. SHRI MAHABALI SINGH:**

**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government is implementing Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) in cities of Bihar and Amravati city of Maharashtra;**
- (b) if so, the details of the works executed in all cities so far under the said plan;**
- (c) the funds approved for these projects; and**
- (d) the time by which these projects are likely to be completed by the Government?**

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE  
MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS  
(SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI)**

- (a). Yes, Sir. Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) scheme is being implemented in 27 selected cities of the State of Bihar and Amravati city of the State of Maharashtra.**

**(b), (c) & (d). Selection, appraisal, approval and implementation of projects under AMRUT are done by the respective States/Union Territories (UTs). Government of India approves the State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) submitted by the States/UTs and releases Central Assistance as per the Mission guidelines.**

**The approved SAAPs of State of Bihar for the entire Mission period amounts to ₹ 2,469.77, which includes committed Central Assistance of ₹ 1,164.80 crore. So far, State of Bihar has taken up 70 projects worth ₹ 2,585.57 crore, of which, 6 projects worth ₹ 241.24 crore have been completed, 58 projects worth ₹ 2,213.92 crore are work in progress and 6 projects worth ₹ 130.41 crore are at various stages of tendering. State of Bihar has taken up projects in excess of approved SAAPs. The entire excess expenditure is to be borne by State of Bihar itself.**

**The city-wise details of projects taken up under AMRUT by the Government of Bihar is given at the ANNEXURE.**

**Government of Maharashtra has taken up 5 projects worth ₹ 201.18 crore in the city of Amravati under AMRUT, of which, 4 projects worth ₹119.31 crore have been completed while 1 project worth ₹81.87 crore is work in progress.**

**Projects under AMRUT are likely to be fully completed by March, 2023.**
