Jal Jeevan Mission (Urban) has been proposed by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme to provide universal coverage of water supply through functional taps to all households in all 4,372 statutory towns/cities of the country and universal coverage of household-level sewerage/septage management in 500 AMRUT (Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation) cities.

State-wise outlays and action plans will be decided after the proposed Mission gets approval of the Government and launched.
