COVID VACCINATION BENEFICIARIES**

3937. KUMARI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of beneficiaries of COVID vaccination as on date, Healthcare Worker and Frontline Worker wise and State/UT-wise;
- (b) the details of specified co-morbidities for determination of eligibility of citizens for vaccination in age group 45 to 59 years;
- (c) the details of persons eligible to apply for vaccination at Co-WIN 2.0 platform and the manner in which the registration is to be done in the Co-WIN platform;
- (d) whether there are any other platforms for vaccine registration, if so, the details thereof;
- (e) the details of the documents required for registration on the Co-WIN platform; and
- (f) whether Co-WIN allows beneficiaries to choose hospitals, vaccines and if so the number of beneficiaries registered on Co-WIN App to get vaccination so far, State/UT-wise?

- (a): The State/UT-wise number of beneficiaries of COVID-19 vaccination, Health Care Worker and Front Line Worker-wise, as on 15th March 2021 is at Annexure 1.
- (b): Detail of 20 specified co-morbidities for determination of eligibility of citizens for vaccination in age group of 45 to 59 years is at Annexure 2.
- (c) & (d): As per the recommendation of the National Expert Group on Vaccine Administration for COVID-19 (NEGVAC), the following categories are eligible for COVID-19 vaccination: Health Care Workers, Front Line Workers, persons aged 60 years and above and persons between 45 to 59 years of age with specified comorbidities.

Registration for vaccination can be done through Co-WIN 2.0 portal/website or through Aarogya Setu app.

- (e): As per the guidance document on COWIN 2.0, any one of the following photo identity documents can be used by citizens for availing online registration: Aadhaar Card, Electoral Photo Identity Card (EPIC), Passport, Driving License, PAN Card, NPR smart card, Pension document with photograph.

- (f) Co-WIN 2.0 has the provision that allows beneficiaries to choose the COVID vaccination centre at the time of online registration.

As of 15th March 2021 a total of 3.05 crore beneficiaries (Health Care Workers, Front Line Workers, persons aged 60 years or more and those between 45- 59 years with comorbidities) are registered on Co-WIN 2.0 portal. The State/UT wise detail is at Annexure 3.

1	Heart Failure with hospital admission in past one year
2	Post Cardiac Transplant/Left Ventricular Assist Device (LVAD)
3	Significant Left ventricular systolic dysfunction (LVEF <40%)
4	Moderate or Severe Valvular Heart Disease
5	Congenital heart disease with severe PAH or Idiopathic PAH
6	Coronary Artery Disease with past CABG/PTCA/MI AND Hypertension/Diabetes on treatment
7	Angina AND Hypertension/Diabetes on treatment
8	CT/MRI documented stroke AND Hypertension/Diabetes on treatment
9	Pulmonary artery hypertension AND Hypertension/Diabetes on treatment
10	Diabetes (> 10 years OR with complications) AND Hypertension on treatment
11	Kidney/ Liver/ Hematopoietic stem cell transplant: Recipient/On wait-list
12	End Stage Kidney Disease on haemodialysis/ CAPD
13	Current prolonged use of oral corticosteroids/ immunosuppressant medications
14	Decompensated cirrhosis
15	Severe respiratory disease with hospitalizations in last two years/FEV1 <50%
