(a) to (c): Government has approved "Broadcasting Infrastructure and Network Development (BIND)" Scheme for Prasar Bharati as part of 12th Plan (2012-17) & Extension of the Scheme of Prasar Bharati (2017-20, which was further extended to 2020-21) at a cost of Rs. 1054.52 crores for 3 years. The scheme has components for modernization and upgradation of capital infrastructure in All India Radio and Doordarshan, as also content development. The objectives of the scheme include Augmentation and Replacement of transmitters and Broadcast Equipment, Digitization of studios, Coverage in sensitive areas, broadcasting on alternate platform, expansion of DTH and High Definition TV channels, etc. The present status of implementation of the scheme is given at Annexure.
