## **HEALTHCARE SERVICES**

### 4010. DR. KALANIDHI VEERASWAMY:

Will the Minister of AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH) be pleased to state:

- (a) the features of the 'Centres of Excellence Scheme' of the Government;
- (b) the details of the funds sanctioned, allocated and utilized under this mission in the country, State/UTwise including Tamil Nadu during the last three years;
- (c) the number of healthcare services being provided under this scheme, State/UT-wise including Tamil Nadu;
- (d) the details of the target set and achievements made so far in this regard in Tamil Nadu;
- (e) whether the Government has planned for upgradation of more AYUSH institutions under this scheme in the country, State/UT-wise including Tamil Nadu; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

### **ANSWER**

# THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS AND ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA, YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

- (a): The features of the 'Centre of Excellence Scheme' of Ministry of AYUSH are as follows:
  - i. Under "Central Sector Scheme for assistance to AYUSH organisations for upgradation to Centres of Excellence(CoE)" Ministry of AYUSH supports AYUSH institutions in Government/ Non-Government sector to upgrade their functions and facilities to levels of excellence.
  - ii. It is a Central Sector Scheme, institutions/organizations engaged in one or more of the activities such as Clinical research, AYUSH Hospitals, Research based on the Fundamentals of AYUSH, Inter-disciplinary research in pharmacology, pharmacy or product development, bridging AYUSH and modern science, tertiary care Allopathic Hospitals having track record of 5 years in AYUSH research and any other specialized area of AYUSH are eligible for assistance.
  - iii. A maximum Rs.10 Crore is approved for the period of three years. Not more than 30% of the Government grant is permitted on civil works.

- iv. The existing facilities of the organization is upgraded to achieve higher standards as may be recognized in the discipline like NABH, GLP, GMP etc., as are acceptable to the Ministry
- v. The Scheme provides for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) of the population at concessional rates/ free of cost from the facilities created under the Scheme.
- (b) & (c): During last three years, Ministry of AYUSH has utilized Rs.20.85 Crore for supporting 13 projects across the country including Tamil Nadu.
