(a) & (b) Setting up of Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) is a concurrent subject under the Constitution wherein the Central Government is entrusted with the responsibility of formulation of policy, laying down training standards, norms, whereas opening of ITIs, implementation of norms and day to day administration rest with the respective State Government Territory concerned including those for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes dominated areas.

Details of existing ITIs in Banswada, Dungarpur and Prayagraj are as follows:
