TEACHERS VACANCIES IN KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS

4301. SHRI KAUSHALENDRA KUMAR: DR. VIRENDRA KUMAR:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of new Kendriya Vidyalaya opened during the last five years, State-wise and place-wise;
- (b) the number of teachers in KVs including regular posts created and recruitments done for the posts of Graduate Teacher (PGT), Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT) and Primary Teacher (PRT) in KVs set up during the last five years, School-wise and category-wise (UR/OBC/SC/ ST) recruitments done till date:
- (c) the number of teachers working on contract basis as PRT, PGT and TGT, School-wise and subject-wise;
- (d) the percentage of contract basis teachers compared to the total sanctioned posts subject-wise and category wise; and
- (e) the steps taken/ being taken by the Government to remove the shortage of the teachers?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')

- (a) During the last five years i.e. 2015-16 to 2019-20, 134 Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) have been opened in the country. State / UT-wise and place-wise details are annexed.
- (b) Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) has informed that the newly opened KVs start from class I to V. These KVs grow year to year up to class XII. Accordingly, the sanction of staff is done every year and is dynamic in nature. The recruitment of staff is not done on school basis. The vacancies of all the KVs are assessed periodically and recruitment is done on all India basis. The year-wise details of 1217

posts of various categories of teachers sanctioned in 134 KVs set up during the last five years i.e. from the year 2015-16 to 2019-20, are as under:-

- (c) & (d) The contractual teachers in KVs are engaged against vacant posts which arise on account of opening of new KVs, transfer, promotion, leave vacancy, retirement etc. The data is dynamic and varies from school to school.
- (e) Filling up of vacancies is a continuous process and action is taken from time to time as per the provisions of the relevant recruitment rules. As the process of filling up of vacancies involves various methods of recruitment such as promotion, Limited Departmental Examination, Direct Recruitment etc. Teachers are also engaged on contractual basis for temporary duration by KVS to ensure that the teaching-learning process is not hampered. The organizations functioning under the Ministry of Education such as KVS, Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti, National Institute of Open Schooling, Central Board of Secondary Education and National Council of Educational Research and Training have been advised to fill up their vacancies in order to increase quality and efficiency.
