EMPLOYMENT IN ENGINEERING/MEDICAL SECTOR

4332. SHRI AJAY BHATT:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the existing training related and other schemes for creation of employment and whether these schemes are helping in providing employment to the people;
- (b) whether employment opportunities have declined in engineering and medical sector; and
- (c) the number of fresh young persons who seek employment in public and private sector each year after completing their education including the statistics of their success rate?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

(a) & (b): The Government is implementing various schemes for providing skill development training to the youth of the country. The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) Scheme and the National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) for short-term training, and Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) through the Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) for long-term training. In addition, the Ministry of Rural Development is implementing Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) and Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETIs) schemes, while the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs is implementing the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM). The number of candidates trained and reported placed under the above schemes since 2016-17 is as under:

(c): As per the results of Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) conducted by National Sample Survey Office, Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation during 2017-18 and 2018-19, the estimated unemployment rate for the persons aged 15 years and above on usual status (principal status + subsidiary status) basis in the country is 6.0% and 5.8% respectively.
