- (b) the scheme-wise allocation made for tribal welfare in the State including Banswara-Dungarpur and expenditure incurred item-wise during the last five years;
- (c) whether all the allocated works have been completed within the time limit or are pending;
- (d) whether any complaint has been received against the executing agencies in terms of the quality of the said development works; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the details the action taken in this regard?

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SMT. RENUKA SINGH SARUTA)

- (a): The names of the schemes being implemented for the development of Scheduled Tribes in Rajasthan and its details are enclosed at **Annexure-I.**
- (b): The scheme wise details of the funds released by Ministry of Tribal Affairs during the last five years on tribal welfare in Rajasthan including Banswara-Dungarpur is enclosed at **Annexure-IIA**, **Annexure-IIB** and Annexure-IIC.
- (c): The Ministry does not have district and block wise allocation details as funds are released to the state governments, the organizations working in the states or directly transferred to the beneficiaries through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT). However, the present status of the EMRS schools sanctioned in Rajasthan is enclosed at **Annexure III.**
- (d)& (e): No complaint has been received in the Grievance cell of the Ministry of Tribal Affairs against the executing agencies in terms of the quality of the said development works.
