**PARADIGM SHIFT IN AGRICULTURE**

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the commitment towards farmers to ensure their prosperity and dignity and prevent dependence on middlemen, in the conventional view of development, only took into account more vocal interest groups ignoring small businessmen and farmers under the new farm laws;
- (b) if so, whether there is a need to bring a paradigm shift in the agricultural sector through kisan credit cards, soil health cards, e-NAM and an effective crop insurance scheme; and
- (c) if so, the details of the steps taken to transform agriculture in the last four years and current year as on date farm-sector-wise and State-wise especially Telangana and Andhra Pradesh and crop-yield-wise along with beneficiaries list of farmers from each scheme identified along with funds incurred for them scheme-wise also and if not, reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c): The New Farm laws viz, “The Farmers' Produce Trade and Commerce (Promotion and Facilitation) Act, 2020”, “The Farmers (Empowerment and Protection) Agreement on Price Assurance and Farm Services Act, 2020” and “The Essential Commodities (Amendment) Act, 2020, are intended to facilitate direct buying from farmers in trade area by traders, processors, exporters, Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs), agriculture co-operative Societies etc., so as to facilitate farmers with better price realization. Farm laws will accelerate more investment in marketing and value addition infrastructure including that in storage facilities near to farm gate creating more employment opportunities for rural youth.

Farm laws provide additional marketing opportunities to farmers for selling their produce outside the Agricultural Produce Market Committee (APMC) market yards such as at farm-gates, cold storages, warehouse, silos, etc. to help farmers to sell their produce to direct buyers without depending on middlemen thus reducing cost of marketing and improving their gain. "The Farmers' Produce Trade and Commerce (Promotion and Facilitation) Act, 2020" is also intended to promote competition and transparency in trade by way of facilitation of electronic trading system in trade area thus helping farmers specially small and marginal farmers in improving their income. This will also encourage APMC markets to be more competitive and efficient in providing cost effective services to the benefit of farmers.

The new farm laws also provide farmers with cost effective, easy time bound dispute resolution system at local level with provision of penalty against traders for contravention of any provision to protect the farmers including small and marginal farmers. Therefore, new farm laws are truly in the interest and benefit of farmers including that of small and marginal farmers to ensure their prosperity and dignity and prevent dependence on middlemen. The traders one the other hand including small businessmen under new farm law of "The Farmers' Produce Trade and Commerce (Promotion and Facilitation) Act, 2020" are free to buy in trade area so far as they comply to provisions of the new farm law.

Since 2014, the Govt. has been implementing various innovative schemes like Kisan Credit Cards, Soil Health Cards, e-NAM and effective crop insurance scheme towards favorable environment to create opportunities for farmers.

Amongst the steps taken, the Govt. of India is implementing Interest Subvention Scheme (ISS) for welfare of farmers which is available for availing short term agri loans upto Rs.3.00 lakh to farmers at an interest rate of 7% per annum for one year. The short term agri loans include crop Husbandry, Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries. Additional 3% subvention is also given to the farmers for prompt and timely repayment of loans; the same gets reduced to 4% per annum. This also ensures their prosperity and dignity and prevents dependence on middlemen. The benefits of ISS have also been extended to farmers in allied activities like Animal Husbandry and Fisheries to existing Kisan Credit Card (KCC) holders within the overall limit of Rs.3.00 lakh and issue of new KCC for Animal Husbandry and Fisheries farmers with provision of benefit of IS &PRI for loan amount upto Rs.2.00 lakh per annum. To bring the maximum number of farmers under KCC in order to provide easy access to concessional institutional credit, Government has taken various initiatives viz. waiving off all kinds of service charges like processing fee, inspection, ledger folio charges for loans upto Rs.3.00 lakh, raising collateral free loan limit for short term agri-credit from Rs.1.00 lakh to Rs.1.60 lakh and extending benefit of KCC to the farmers practicing Animal Husbandry and Fisheries. There is no state-wise allocation/release under the ISS. However, details of funds released under ISS for the last four years [2016-17 to 2019-20] is Rs.54,157.27Cr and for the current year 2020-21 is Rs.16826.19Cr. The total number of operative KCC accounts statewise and agency wise is given at **Annexure-I**.

Soil Health Card Scheme has been introduced in year 2014-15 to assist State Governments to issue soil health cards to all farmers in the country. Soil health card provides information to farmers on nutrient status of their soil along with recommendation on appropriate dosage of nutrients to be applied for improving soil health and its fertility. In Cycle-I (2015 to 2017), 10.74 crore soil health cards and in Cycle-II (2017 to 2019), 11.93 crore soil health cards were distributed to farmers. In Model Village Programme (2019-20), 18.74 lakh soil health cards were distributed to farmers across the country. In order to motivate farmers towards regular soil testing and adoption of soil testing recommendations, farmer's trainings in 98530 identified villages is being organized by States/UTs through Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) / State Agricultural Universities (SAUs) during 2020-21. So far, 57,135 demonstrations and 41,017 trainings have been organized for farmers by States/UTs. State-wise details of farmers including that of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana is at **Annexure-II**.

Govt. of India has also implemented e-NAM scheme which is a virtual platform integrating physical wholesale mandis/ markets of different States/ Union Territories (UTs) to facilitate online trading of agriculture and horticulture commodities through transparent price discovery method to enable farmers to realize better remunerative prices for their produce. So far, 1000 Agricultural Produce Market Committees (APMCs) markets have been integrated in 18 States and 03 UTs. State-wise details of funds released including that of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana is at **Annexure-III**. So far more than 1.7 Crore farmers have been registered with e-NAM out of which 14.41 lakh farmers are from Andhra Pradesh and 18.23 Lakh farmers are from Telangana.

Government is implementing the crop insurance schemes since 1985. These schemes are evaluated from time to time taking in to account the experience gained and views of the stakeholders. Accordingly, yield based Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) and weather index based Restructured Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme (WBCIS) has been introduced from Kharif 2016 season to provide financial support to farmers suffering crop loss/damage arising out of natural calamities, adverse weather incidence and to stabilize the income of farmers etc. Comprehensive risk insurance is provided under the scheme from pre-sowing to post-harvest losses. The Operational Guidelines of the PMFBY/RWBCIS have further been revised and revamped w.e.f. Rabi 2018 and Kharif 2020 respectively. State wise details of farmers benefited is at **Annexure-IV**.

Apart from the above schemes, the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) is a Central Sector Scheme, being implemented since 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2019. The Scheme aims at providing financial assistance to landholding farmer families across the country, subject to certain exclusion criteria, to enable them to take care of expenses related to agriculture and allied activities as well as domestic needs. Under the Scheme, an amount of Rs. 6000/- per year is transferred in three 4-monthly installments of Rs.2000/- directly into the bank accounts of the farmers. State-wise details of benefits and funds under PM-KISAN is at **Annexure-V**.
