- (a) the total number of Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) which received foreign funds during the last three years in Bihar;
- (b) the quantum of foreign funds received by NGOs during the said, period, year-wise and State-wise;
- (c) whether such NGOs are submitting audited records as required under the existing laws; and
- (d) if not, the nature of action taken by the Government to ensure submission of audited records?

(a): Total number of NGOs which received foreign contribution during the last three years in Bihar is as under:-

(b) to (d): The Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 2010 and rules made there-under provide that all FCRA NGOs/Associations have to file audited Annual Returns upto a fixed deadline. The non-compliant NGOs are issued notices and questionnaires. Further action like audit & inspection of defaulting NGOs is also carried out. This may lead to suspension and cancellation of their Registration Certificates.
