GROWTH OF FPI SECTOR

**4466. SHRI KAPIL MORESHWAR PATIL:**

Will the Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government envisages and is expecting the processed food market to grow to \$ 543 billion by 2020, a very high increase from mere \$32.2 billion in 2016 and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has recently sanctioned 32 projects in food processing sector with an investment of about Rs 406 Cr under Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sampada Yojana (PMKSY) which is having a total outlay of Rs 6000 Cr for the implementing period 2016-20; and
- (c) whether the Government proposes and has identified more projects to fast track in this sector and if so, the details of the projects under consideration?

**ANSWER**

(a): The Gross Value Added (GVA) of the food processing sector increased continuously from Rs.1.30 lakh crore in 2013-14 to Rs 1.61 lakh crore in 2015-16 and further to Rs. 2.08 lakh crore in 2018-19. The size of processed food market expands along with the increase in the size of GVA of the food processing sector.

(b): The Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana (PMKSY) was launched in July 2017 with an allocation of Rs. 6,000 crore for the period 2016-20 (extended up to 2020-21) with 7 component schemes namely; (i) Mega Food Park (MFP) (ii) Integrated Cold Chain and Value Addition Infrastructure (ICC) (iii) Creation / Expansion of Food Processing & Preservation Capacities (CEFPPC) (iv) Infrastructure for Agro-Processing Clusters (APC) (v) Creation of Backward & Forward linkages (CBFL) (vi) Food Safety and Quality Assurance Infrastructure (FTL), and (vii) Human Resource and Institutions. Operation Green was added as the 8<sup>th</sup> sub-scheme during 2018-19.

During the year 2020-21, the Ministry of Food Processing Industries has sanctioned 155 projects with total project cost of Rs. 3305.19 crore and grant of Rs. 1051.34 crore. The scheme-wise projects and grant approved during 2020-21 are indicated as under:

(c): Besides PMKSY, the Ministry is implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme- PM Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises Scheme (PMFME) from the year 2020-21 for providing financial, technical and business support for upgradation / setting up of 2 lakh micro food processing enterprises based on One District One Product (ODOP) approach. The scheme is being implemented for the period 2020-21 to 2024-25 with an outlay of Rs. 10,000 crore.

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
