# MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a) Pradhan Mantri Gram SadakYojana (PMGSY) is a one-time special intervention of Government of India to provide rural connectivity, by way of a single all-weather road, to the eligible unconnected habitations in the core network. The unit for PMGSY is a habitations and not a revenue village or a Panchayat.

The number of habitations connected so far under PMGSY (250+ & 500+ population habitations) in the country as on  $17^{th}$  March, 2021 is as under: -
